Content Caching

Content caching is Apple's free, built-in network caching solution on macOS designed to minimize bandwidth usage for Apple content. It speeds up downloading of software distributed by Apple and data that users store in iCloud by saving content that local Mac, iOS, and Apple TV devices have already downloaded. Saved content is stored in a content cache on a Mac, and is available for other devices to retrieve without going out over the Internet.
